Reflection - PENTECOST - May 23, 2021 Fr. Gary Luiten

Today is the Feast Day of the Holy Spirit. It's the third person of the Trinity - the person that is perhaps least understood of the three. The Holy Spirit did many good things for the apostles. It gave them abilities they never had before. They received the seven-fold gifts. And God gives to us, by virtue of our baptisms, the seven-fold gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, fortitude, piety, and fear of the Lord. The Holy Spirit is more important for us and more active in our lives than we may realize. It is the very life of God which powers our own spirits.

Our spirits need the Holy Spirit in order to function, in order to be at peace, in order to do what God has called us to do - to follow our general calling as Christians, as members of the Church Jesus has set up, which, by the way, was born on this day – on Pentecost. The church teaches that we receive the Holy Spirit most powerfully in the Sacraments such as the Eucharist and Reconciliation. This is the day when Jesus began that Sacrament, too, when He told the apostles to go out and forgive people's sins, to lead them closer to God. What a gift God has given to the church, for us to use often.

There are nice benefits to living the life of the Spirit and being open to the Holy Spirit in our lives. They are called "fruits." And perhaps you have heard of the fruits of the Holy Spirit, which include Joy, peace, patience, goodness, mildness, faith, modesty, and chastity.

At this point, we have our Catholic faith placed before us. God has sent Jesus to us. He has risen, he ascended, and he descended upon the apostles, coming back to us. The faith has now been offered to us. May we take the example of the apostles – and have the courage and the desire to practice and share what has been handed on to us, and to grow closer to God and the Church which He has given us, to help lead us to heaven.






