The cross that once was on the top of Cardinal Muench Seminary has found a new home here at Blessed Sacrament, in our Prayer Garden. The Prayer Garden has new benches, and a new statue and our Lady of the Prairie (Mary) statue has a new coat of paint! This has become such a beautiful prayerful area. Bishop Folda will be dedicating the cross and blessing the garden on June 6 after 10:30 Mass, following the Eucharistic Procession. Please join us in celebrating our Prayer Garden! Eucharistic Procession – What is it?

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the whole Christian life. A eucharistic procession, is a public witness of the veneration toward the most holy Eucharist, conducted through public streets. This earthly journey reminds the Catholic faithful of their spiritual journey toward eternal life with God.

On our Feast Day, the Bishop will take a consecrated host (the real and substantial presence of Jesus Christ: body, blood, soul, and divinity) and place it within the monstrance. The monstrance will then be lifted



and carried by the Bishop who will lead the faithful in procession. The Bishop will walk under a canopy held by 4th Degree Knights of Columbus. While processing

the faithful will recite the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, led by Fr. Gary Luiten.

Blessed Sacrament has never celebrated its Feast Day with a Eucharistic Procession. Join us in the making of history at Blessed Sacrament, June 6 following 10:30 a.m. Mass.

Reflections on Trinity Sunday - June 30, 2021 - Fr. Gary Luiten

How appropriate is the gospel passage for today on this Trinity Sunday weekend, when Jesus tells the apostles to go out and baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Here Jesus is speaking of all three persons of the Blessed Trinity.

Someone someday might come up to you and say, "But the bible doesn't even mention the word, "trinity." So why do you believe in a trinity? One answer we can give them is the word "trinity" is a lot easier to say than, "The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit." One can just say "trinity," which means "three-in-one." Also, a belief in the Trinity is part of our faith tradition. Not all our faith is contained in the Scriptures. Sacred Scripture is one of many different ways God communicates to us, but He doesn't limit himself to the words of the Bible.

A good question to ponder is, "Do you believe in the Trinity?" Maybe you have times of doubt. If so, have no fear -- you are in good company! There were times that all eleven of the apostles in the gospel today doubted. But that didn't stop the Holy Spirit from coming into their lives and transforming them, giving them the grace to spread the faith. All but one died a martyr's death. They allowed God to change their minds - to accept, profess, and spread the truth they received in Jesus.

We can allow God to change us, too, to mold us into the image of God. Before we go to bed tonight, let us think of the many different ways the Trinity has graced us today with His presence. There are many ways the Trinity bestows graces upon us, such as in the Eucharist. Perhaps God also will grace us through the presence of family and friends. May we never take for granted the Trinity's many graces to us. May we be truly a thankful people, thanking God for the gift of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.


