Reflection on the Readings for the Second Sunday of Lent - March 13, 2022 <u>Lent: A Season of Prayer</u>

A common element to the readings today is prayer. And prayer is quite appropriate to talk about during Lent since prayer is one of the three actions that are emphasized during this season, along with fasting and almsgiving. The topic of prayer is mentioned in over 180 Scripture verses. 119 verses contain the word "pray."

And we know there is power behind prayer. In the first reading, Abraham prayed, and it changed his life. He received land, descendants, and a long life. When Jesus prayed in the gospel today, it changed his appearance.

Prayer has been explained by many different people. The Catechism of the Catholic Church even devotes 300 paragraphs on prayer in paragraphs 2566-2865. It quotes St. John Damascene, one of the Church Fathers, who states that prayer is "The raising of one's mind and heart to God or requesting good things from God." St. Theresa of Lisieux, a doctor of the church, a young Carmelite who died in her 20's, states that prayer "is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." Notice, in both of these definitions, the heart is mentioned. So, when we pray, we really shouldn't just go "through the actions," but turn to God from deep down inside, and give to Him our whole selves.

There are 4 basic types of prayer: Adoration and Praise, Petition, Intercession, and thanksgiving. Intercessory prayer is praying for others, including the deceased. Then when we leave this life, hopefully there will be people praying for us. And if we are missing one or more of these, then we should begin to use all of them. They are all present in the Lord's prayer. So, when we pray the Our Father, we can't go wrong.

May we use the opportunities given to us as individuals and as families to pray, especially during this season of prayer, this season of Lent, thereby drawing ourselves closer to Jesus and His Church.

I also have a few other items for this month...




