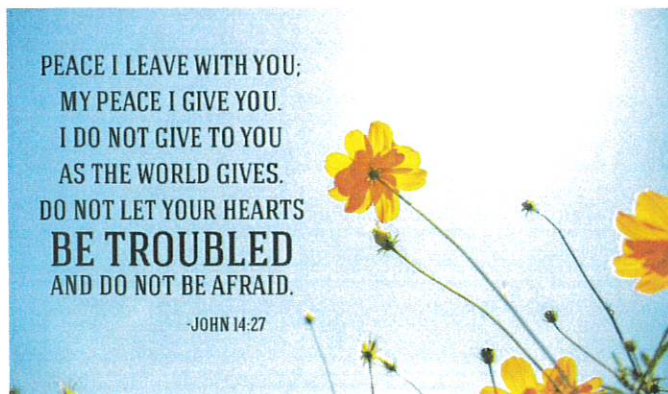

## **Reflections on the Gospel for the 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter - May 22, 2022**

**Fr. Gary Luiten**

The key word in today's gospel is peace. Jesus loved that word. And he loved what it stood for. Notice that when Jesus rose from the dead, it was the first word he said to the apostles when he stood before them. And peace was also one of the last words Jesus mentions before he ascended to the Father.

The opposite of peace would be unrest, or violence. And we know there is a lot of unrest in the world today. The Ukraine is one such example. A few years ago, I saw a map of the world, showing all the countries that exist in the world. There were over 200. Many were at unrest. Over 55 countries were either in a state of flux or had occurrences of conflict! And we don't have to look over seas to see unrest, conflict, and violence. There is a lot of violence and unrest right here in our own country. Violence comes right into our homes on TV and the internet. And violence can exist in families at times. But life doesn't have to be this way.

Notice that Jesus also qualifies that word "peace." He said, "I do not give peace to you as the world gives peace." We know how the world gives peace. One nation will promise peace with another. They will make peace accords, and years or even months later they are back fighting again. Rather, Jesus gives us a lasting peace. So, we need to pray more than ever that people receive Christ into their lives. Because with Christ comes the neat by-product of peace.

Let us pray, then, that we will find that peace of mind that the Gentiles received from God through the preaching and teaching of Paul, Barnabas, and the apostles. And may the peace that comes from God always remain strong in our hearts, even in the midst of our burdens.
