Reflections on the Solemnity of the Ascension - May 29, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

It is a busy time of year. 'Tis the season for weddings, anniversaries, and graduations. As seniors graduate from high school, they are moving on and their parents, though excited for their son or daughter's future, are oftentimes sad to see them go.

The disciples find themselves in a similar situation in the gospel today. It seems that Jesus' disciples were going to miss Jesus when he ascended to heaven. They kept staring at the empty sky. They had to be reminded that Jesus would return. And so it was kind of a bittersweet time for the disciples. After all, it was the Father's will that the Holy Spirit would not be sent until Jesus ascended to the Father.

Our Lord's ascension provides us a great opportunity to think of the afterlife. It is an element of our faith that there is a hell, where those who have been unfaithful to God without repenting place themselves. It is not a good place. It is a place of eternal punishment – eternal separation from God. It is not spiritually healthy to preoccupied with such a place, but to know that it is there, so we can avoid placing ourselves there.

And it would be quite presumptuous for me to think that, after I die, God will take me straight to heaven. I personally need time to spiritually become spotlessly clean before I see God - and this place is called purgatory, taught by the Church in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraphs 1023-1033, and referred to indirectly in Sacred Scripture. And hell and purgatory are good for us to think of from time to time, just to remind us they are there. But they are not good to be preoccupied with.

And, finally, last but certainly not least, it is an element of our faith that there is also a heaven: a reward for those who have been faithful in this life. Paul: "Eye has not seen, ear has not heard, nor has it so much as dawned on us what God has ready for those who love him." In heaven, we will be able to see Jesus clearly. It is where we can meet Jesus in his glorified body. And it is where we can meet his mother, Mary, and all the saints: those people we have asked for intercessory help. Heaven is where we hope to meet our friends and where we can enjoy all the things we like to do, and more!

Jesus has set the example and goal for us by ascending into heaven. May we become people who live with heaven as our goal through keeping the Lord's word by faithfully receiving him and living his command of love.




