Reflections on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ - June 19, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

A great introduction to my thoughts for the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, really is the first reading this weekend are from the book of Genesis that we heard today, in particular the blessing that Melchizedek gives Abram. Two important points are to be noted in this blessing.

The first point involves the words that are used. These words later become part of the traditional Jewish blessing. And these words also find their way into the Eucharist we celebrate. Perhaps those words sound familiar. At Mass, when the priest prepares the gifts to be offered, he says, "Blessed are You, Lord, God of all creation..." These are the words used to prepare the Bread and Wine to become the Body and Blood of Christ!

Secondly, notice the objects used in the blessing. Melchizedek blesses Abram with bread and wine. Now the Jewish people hearing these verses before the time of Christ would not understand the importance of the bread and the wine. But now we do, don't we? Indeed, God graces us with Himself in the form of bread and wine! And so, those two points make us think of the Eucharist. And it is specifically the Body and Blood of Jesus which we highlight today.

Our faith is not just a spiritual thing, but it also involves many physical things, including the Eucharist we receive! When we really come to understand the real meaning of the true presence of Jesus Himself in the Eucharist, suddenly other daily passing events mean hardly anything compared to receiving God physically as well as Spiritually. This is where the Divine meets the human.

My thoughts are drawn to the picture on the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel, Where God is creating humanity, and God and Adam's fingers are touching. What an awesome moment when the divine and human meet. And here at Mass is where the Divine and the Human meet in the most complete and total way, this side of heaven where Jesus meets us in a complete, even bodily way!

After we have met and received Jesus in the Eucharist, then we are ready to go out and to live the gospel message. We have all we need to do Jesus' will in our lives, to carry out the commandments and to be at peace with God and others.
