**Reflections on the readings for the 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday  
in Ordinary Time - June 26, 2022  
Fr. Gary Luiten**

When we really want a product of some sort – whether it be food or an appliance, everything has a cost. Being a follower of Jesus has a cost, too. Paul says in the second reading today, "Live according to the Spirit and you will not yield to the cravings of the flesh." And so, the cost is: "Live according to the Spirit, not the flesh." Paul, here, is saying that one must give up one's former ways. One must give up being led by the desires of the flesh. And the way we avoid being led by the desires of the flesh is by doing the positive, by living according to the Spirit, as Paul says. We live this out by thinking more of the needs of our neighbor than our personal desires. Moms and dads are usually pretty good at this – always thinking of the needs of their children.

Another thing discipleship will cost us is to give up looking back at, or going back to our old lives of sin. Jesus says, "Anyone who puts his hand to the plow but keeps looking back is unfit for the reign of God." This involves giving up our own agendas and plans.

And that is the cost of discipleship. It is true, Jesus paid the price for our sins when He died for us on the cross. And now He calls us to give up our own agendas, and let God be in charge -- to let God be the head of the house and, continue to let Jesus do the leading in our Church. So, as you can see, discipleship comes with a cost, but, considering the rewards, the price is worth it. May God give us the courage and strength to let him be the Lord of our lives, and may we humbly learn to submit our wills to that of Christ. May our will be not so much what I want, but what God wants of me.
