

Stewardship Moment

Pentecost Sunday

"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you."

John 14:26

The materialism of our society lures us to concentrate more on what we want than on what God wants for us. The relativism of our world tells us that we should be tolerant of all things, that there is no absolute truth. Pray to the Holy Spirit to transform our lives and to guide our thoughts, words and actions.

Reflections on Pentecost Sunday June 5, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

Although some early church writers say that the church was born from the side of Christ on the cross, when blood and water flowed from his open wound, tradition tells us that the church's birthday is on Pentecost – the 50th day of Easter, today, when the Holy Spirit came down upon the apostles and sent them out to proclaim the good news and to celebrate what we call the "sacraments."

Because of the sending of the Holy Spirit about 2,000 years ago, each one of us today now has gifts. Besides the 7-fold gifts. God also gives us the Holy Spirit! This is shown in the breath that Jesus gave to the disciples. It says in the gospel that "he 'breathed' on them." Whether we want to admit it or not, each one of us, at times, is out of air, spiritual air, as a result of our own sinfulness, selfishness, or laziness. Medical doctors will tell you that it is important to have a good set of lungs - to be able to inhale air, and not just any air, but fresh air. Since we are not just bodies, but also spirits, it is crucial for us to inhale the breath of the Holy Spirit too. And this is done through the frequent receptions of the signs of God's life - the Sacraments that Jesus gave us.

And so, what is the proper response to inhaling the Holy Spirit? Well, doctors will also tell you that Exhaling is important, too. The proper response to receiving the Holy Spirit is to share or exhale the Holy Spirit. We exhale when we share the gift of the Holy Spirit. Once we receive the Holy Spirit, we mustn't be afraid to share it. May we truly come to realize our need for the Holy Spirit, and rediscover that the burning desire God has planted in each of our hearts is not a desire for some created thing, but a desire for the Holy Spirit, a desire for the Father - our creator, and Jesus, our savior.
