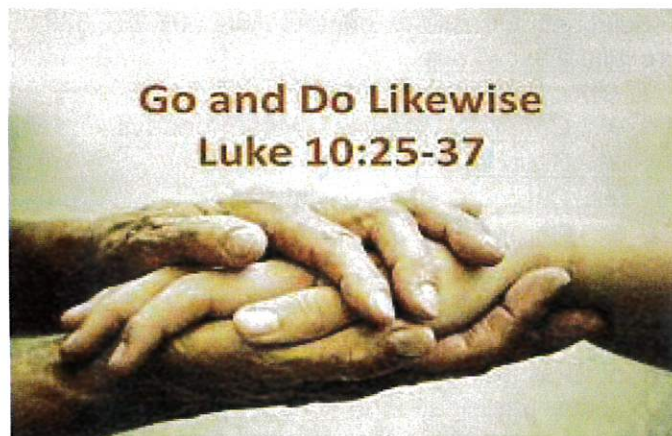

We are called for a three-year (2022-2025) grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States in particular, and through us to the rest of the world, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and sent out in mission "For the life of the world."

Our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength. Jesus Christ invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith – his Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. The importance of the Eucharist in Christian Spirituality is an undisputable fact. The Eucharist offers us an action plan for Life. When Jesus said "Do this in memory of me" he was inviting all people to begin a new lifestyle; a life of sharing their blessings and bearing others burdens. The Eucharist being so precious and beyond human imagination in its significance in our lives, it is vitally important to approach this sacrament with right respect and disposition. To make our participation in the Eucharist meaningful and experiential. We share with you the following:

1. Reverence
Proper attitude brings proper disposition.
2. Preparation.
We need to develop a way to create the right disposition.
3. Participation
We need to attend and celebrate the real presence of God at the Holy Eucharist with deep faith and trust in the Lord and enjoy the beauty of life, the God given gift.

Reflections on the Readings for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 10, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

We hear in the Responsorial Psalm this weekend, "Turn to the Lord in your need, and you will live." What a profound verse of scripture to ponder. First of all, this verse presumes that we all have needs.

We all have physical needs – like our health. The man in the gospel who was beaten and lying on the roadside realized this. It doesn't say that he turned to the Lord, but we can presume he did. The man was helped, by the Samaritan. We have needs like shelter – a place to live. We have needs such as clothing.

We also have spiritual needs. These are the needs we cannot see – the needs that some people don't realize they even have, such as the need to be fed spiritually by God. We have the need to be loved. That is one reason, I am sure, that Jesus calls us to love our neighbor.

In the gospel, a scholar of the law, we could say, a "lawyer" - asked Jesus what He must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus asks, "What is written in the law?" And that is when the lawyer tells him to love God and neighbor. That's when Jesus drives home to the Jewish lawyer that his neighbor includes even the Samaritans, who were not well liked by the Jewish people. And so, loving our neighbor even includes loving our enemies – those who don't like us.

May we realize that we have the need to love and be loved, and have that right, too. And may we turn to the Lord with these needs, so we may, to love others rightly, and have eternal life.

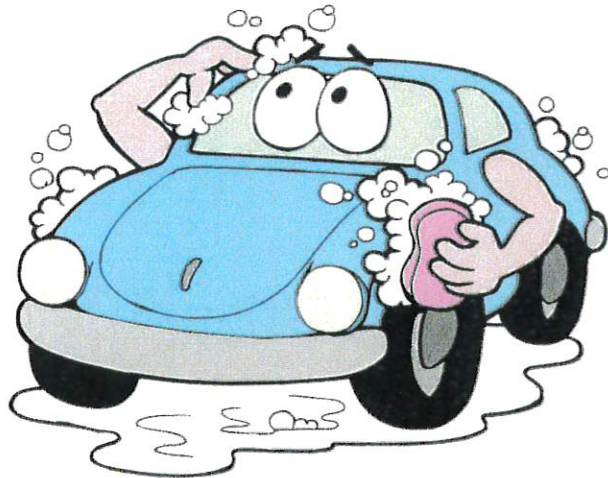
