

Reflections on the Readings for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 17, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

The common theme in the readings this weekend is to welcome and serve others. In the first reading today, we see Abraham, the grandfather of our faith, by the terebinth of Mamre. A terebinth is a small tree of the sumac family (although it is not poisonous), from which some kinds of turpentine are extracted. And Mamre, a town about 20 miles south of Jerusalem. These few verses tell us many things.

In this first reading, God reveals some of his qualities. For example, we see how near God is to us. God certainly was near to Abraham, coming in the form of three men to speak to him. God is near to us, too, even though it seems that He is a million miles away at times. We also see qualities about Abraham. He is a man of God who welcomed God into His life. We can learn from Abraham to continue to deepen our spirit of service and to welcome God. In the gospel today, we, too, see a spirit of welcoming service. Martha waits on Jesus. She served Jesus. Aside from Martha's worrying, she is a good example of service.

And so, we have two examples of welcoming service today: Abraham and Martha. You and I are called to welcome and serve God in our lives. We welcome God when we attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days (and even during the week when we can!) Jesus knocks on the door to our hearts every Sunday, and even every day. And by our coming to Mass, we let Him in so he can take residence in a special way in our lives. Welcoming Jesus in the Eucharist doesn't benefit Jesus so much as it benefits us. Jesus can work miracles in our lies when we welcome him.

Besides welcoming Jesus, since Jesus is present in one another, we are also called to welcome others. One way of welcoming others is to simply spend time with them – and not necessarily say much at all. And so, may God give us the grace and strength to continue to be a people who welcome God and others into our lives each day.


