

# Reflection on the Readings for the 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time - September 11, 2022 Fr. Gary Luiten

Basically, in a nutshell, God is telling us in the gospel today, "I will show you mercy." Perhaps we all can relate to the prodigal son at times. Sometimes we can get sidetracked in our calling losing sight of the shepherd and come back asking God's mercy.

Perhaps some of you parents can relate to the parent or the father in the parable of the prodigal son. You'll see by the end of the parable that the father is a sign of the mercy of God the Father. And that is something that we can all learn from in the gospel. God is telling us that despite what we do to him, God is willing to forgive us, and not just forgive us, but welcome us with open arms so our relationship with God becomes deeper than ever!

The Lord in the readings this weekend is calling us to repentance. And not only that, but calling us not to be afraid of repenting. The Lord is not going berate us or shame us. The shepherd is just so glad to have his sheep back again! This is like the Father in heaven when we repent. And these readings also tell us that God is lavish with his mercy. We could even say that God is almost "wasteful" with his mercy.

God does not spare any mercy to those who ask. But we **must ask** for mercy. This is where an act of sorrow, also called an act of contrition is important for the small sins, and the sacrament of confession is important for the big sins.

May we respond to God's lavish mercy and forgiveness by accepting God's offer of forgiveness often, by giving thanks to God often, and by showing mercy to others. May we be quick to forgive one another.


