



Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



Reflections on the Third Sunday of Easter April 23, 2023

At a time when we hear of tensions are rising throughout the world and talk about war and death, the readings today are just the opposite: they are talking about life! The disciples testify to that fact in the gospel today.

Notice what Jesus emphasizes in today's gospel passage. The first thing He does on that first Easter Sunday is he meets two men on the way to a nearby town and he walks with them. And in this encounter with them, Jesus does two things. He talks to them about the scriptures, and he ate with them.

Do those two things that Jesus, Cleopas and the other disciple did sound familiar: getting together and talking about the scriptures, and then taking bread, blessing it, breaking it, and eating it? It should! It is what we do at Mass. We are receiving the Bread from heaven: Jesus' body and blood! And hopefully, like Cleopas and the other disciple we recognize Jesus in the encounter at Mass.

Jesus wants us to know that it is He that we are receiving in the Eucharist, and that He goes with us in the Eucharist when we leave today. Notice that after Jesus disappeared from their sight, they remembered their hearts burned within them when they listened to Jesus' words. May our hearts also burn within us for Jesus. And may we come to a truer understanding of what it is that we are receiving each time we celebrate the Eucharist, that we are receiving the food for everlasting life.

Eucharistic Revival



How can Jesus Christ be truly present in what still appears to be bread and wine? In the liturgical act known as the epiclesis, the celebrant, speaking in the person of Jesus Christ, calls upon the Father to send down his Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, and this change occurs through the institution narrative, by the power of the words of Christ pronounced by the celebrant.
