

Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



Pentecost - May 28, 2023

Every living thing has a birthday or hatch day or some day when they came into this world. The church is no exception. It is indeed a living thing. The Body of Christ too, has a birthday. Prior to the descent of the Holy Spirit, the church was beginning to take shape and be formed not nine months earlier, but three years earlier, when Jesus chose his apostles and began to gather the disciples and form them into what would later be the church.

Although some early church writers say that the church was born from the side of Christ on the cross when blood and water flowed from his open wound, tradition tells us that the church's birthday is on Pentecost, which is the fiftieth day of Easter, when the Holy Spirit came down upon the apostles and sent them out to proclaim the good news and to celebrate what we call the "sacraments."

It is because of the sending of the Holy Spirit about two thousand years ago that each one of us today now has the seven-fold gifts. The Spirit gives gifts. And who of us don't like to receive gifts? One gift that is really not one of the seven-fold gifts and yet is graciously given by God is the gift of peace. Peace is a great gift that is given. I notice this especially when I walk out of the reconciliation room after going to confession, and also after having received Jesus in the Eucharist.

May we truly come to realize our need for the Holy Spirit and rediscover that the burning desire God has planted in each of our hearts is not a desire for some created thing but a desire for the Holy Spirit, the Father, and the Son.






