

Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



The readings today focus on the great and incomprehensible love that God has for us. And because of this, God is here to protect us, and we have nothing to fear. Jeremiah the prophet sums it up best when he says, "The Lord is with me; he has rescued the life of the poor...!" We see here how God loves Jeremiah. Jeremiah is worth something to the Lord, as are we. Unfortunately, we do not hear those words enough. Even if we turn away from God the Lord still gently calls us back. Sometimes fear keeps us from doing what is right. We should never be intimidated in not doing what is right. If we pray, partake of the sacraments, and keep commandments, we've got nothing to worry about! The only time we have something to worry about is when we turn away from God.

Adam is our example here, as Paul reminds us in his letter to the Romans. And indeed, he had something to worry about – sin and death! And yet God is willing to forgive us and for us to be reconciled with him and one another.

The opposite of fear is courage. The gospel reminds us of that. We should not fear but be courageous in proclaiming Jesus from the housetops. Christianity is a courageous faith. Someday the only thing that is going to matter is how we lived out our faith, not how much money we made or how many fishing trips we took, or how many golf or card games we played, although these may be important for a well-rounded life.

May God help us to take pride in our faith in the good sense of the word. May we not be ashamed of our faith or be embarrassed by it. May God give us an increase of grace to have the courage to live and spread our faith in Jesus.
