



Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



The 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 9, 2023

Today there are many tired and weary people in the world: people out of work, people tired of work, people tired of looking for work, people tired of each other. There are times when I, too, have weary days. I don't think I'm different than all of you. I suspect we all have those days, weeks, or months, when nothing seems to go right and we seem to be fighting an up-hill battle. In response to that, Jesus says in this weekend's gospel, "Come to me, and I will give you rest." And notice he doesn't say, "Go to drugs, alcohol, or other vices. He says, "Come to ME, and I will give you rest! I can satisfy you better than any created thing."

Sometimes only Jesus can give us refreshment and not even sleep seems to refresh. Jesus tells us by means of the Church how to come to Him: Through the sacraments he gave us. God gives us two special sacraments that help to ease the burden and give us rest and refreshment which are the anointing of the sick and reconciliation. Anointing of the sick helps a person understand sickness and either be cured, or to use it as an experience to grow to maturity in Christ. Reconciliation gives a certain peace that nothing else can give.

And, since Jesus is the one who gives us rest and refreshment, and since we are called to be like Christ, you and I are called also to help give others rest and refreshment to others, and to help to ease one another's burdens. May the Eucharist that we partake in this reason help us to give rest and refreshment to those in need.




