



Greetings Parishioners,

I hope this note finds you all well back home at Blessed Sacrament. My sabbatical is flying by, and soon I will begin the "scenic route" journey back home by way of Florida. Since I wrote to you last, I have visited the holocaust museum in Washington, DC, the Basilica of the Assumption here in Baltimore (which is our nation's first cathedral), the St. Francis Xavier Catholic church in Compton, MD (which is the oldest catholic church in continuous operation in the 13 original colonies), and have visited our 5 seminarians at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD. I have also seen many other historic places and museums, and continue to take classes in Medical Ethics, Prophets, and the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles. I continue to offer daily Mass and I offer the Mass at least once a week for you and your intentions. The weather is finally not as humid. I need a jacket occasionally. I hear the weather is going to give me a rude awakening when I arrive home December 1! Thank you for the prayers and let us continue to keep each another in prayer.


