

Lent ends with the start of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on <u>Holy Thursday</u>. This year, Lent ends on March 28, 2024.

When is Good Friday?

Good Friday takes place between Palm Sunday and Easter. This year. Good Friday is on March 29, one day after Holy Thursday,

Good Friday recognizes the day of Christ's crucifixion — the most solemn day of the year for Christians. It is a day for us to turn our gaze to the cross and recognize Christ's most loving sacrifice for us.

When is Holy Saturday?

Holy Saturday, also known as the Easter Vigil, is the day between Good Friday - Jesus' crucifixion and Easer Sunday - the resurrection of Jesus. This vear. Holy Saturday is on March 30.

Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



Palm Sunday - March 24, 2024

As we drive along highways, we see billboards advertising many things. Some billboards simply advertise advertising. The signs will say, "Rent This Space." But what if there had been highway billboards on the weekend of that first Palm Sunday? Maybe the apostles would have rented space, placing a message, something like: "Welcome, Jesus the Messiah! Live long and prosper!" or "Jesus our king tonight: Romans take flight!" Certainly, Jesus wouldn't have approved of such advertising. Nor would he have needed it. Today, the cross becomes the billboard for Jesus' message. As we die to self with Christ and come to life again in Him, the "King of the Jews" becomes our king.

This day was a rather easy one for Christ, at least physically speaking. He was treated royally. But we know that Jesus, in a few short days from then, would go through his terrible agony and torturous death for us.

We, too, are called to go with Christ to Calvary – to carry our crosses and follow Him, not only in the church events of this coming week (which you can note in the bulletin), but also in our daily lives by dying to our own self-centeredness and saying "Yes" to Jesus. Then, we become the spiritual billboards proclaiming Jesus as the King by what we say and do. May God work in each one of us through the events this coming week to grow even closer to Jesus, His mother, His church, and to one another in charity.


