

#### Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten



the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter - April 7, 2024

In the gospel today, Jesus tells the disciples, "If you forgive men's sins, they are forgiven them. If you hold them bound, they are held bound." What great words to reflect and ponder on this Divine Mercy Sunday and how Jesus here gave the church the Sacrament of Forgiveness: Confession! And, indeed, one way to go along and die with Christ is dying to our sinfulness, which is what we focused on during Lent.

The one person besides Jesus, which the gospel revolves around today, is Thomas. If we take a deeper look at Thomas, perhaps we all find that we are a little like Thomas. Although Thomas is known as the doubter, in this weekend's gospel, Thomas and the other apostles would soon be good examples of courage and loyalty for us. It takes courage to stand up for our faith and for Christ, to defend Jesus and His word, which is what Thomas eventually did.

Notice, one other aspect of Thomas' life: He became a believer because He Saw Christ. Now, we may not be able to put our hands into His side, and we may not be able to touch the wounds in His hands, at least not in this life, but we can do one thing that Thomas did, and that is to "see Christ." We can experience Him and recognize Him as He is present in the world today. And when we visit those people who are sick, those people who are suffering, those people who are emotionally distraught, those people who need a helping hand, it is really the Lord whom we are serving. That's where Jesus is present.

May we have the courage, like Thomas did, and be willing to go and to die with Christ, dying to selfishness and all those things that are not of the Lord. And may we, too, have the courage to say to Jesus, as Thomas did, "My Lord and my God."

# Since this is the first bulletin of the month of April, I have two other items for you.

- The National Eucharistic Congress. This will be held in Indianapolis from July 17- 21. We have four people so far representing Blessed Sacrament who have registered and plan on attending. I will be among the four. We have raised a significant amount for the trip, but still need to raise an additional \$2,300. If you are able and feel called to help, there will be an envelope attached to the bulletin within the next couple of weeks asking for your help. Any assistance is greatly appreciated.
- Confirmation and First Eucharist. Next Sunday, April 14, Bishop Folda will be here to confirm our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders and give them their first Eucharist. There will be 16 youth receiving sacraments that day. Also, please note that this will be at our usual 10:30 a.m. Mass. This will be a longer service and the church will be full. You may want to plan accordingly. Please keep the youth in your prayers as they receive these awesome sacraments.






