

Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten

the 2nd Sunday of Lent - March 16, 2025

In this weekend's gospel, Jesus gives Peter, James, and John the shock of their lives when he was transformed before their eyes. What happened was that Jesus let a little of the brightness of his divinity show through.

Scripture doesn't say why Jesus allowed himself to be transfigured in front of Peter, James, and John. But one thing we can be reasonably sure of, and that is the Faith of Peter, James, and John was strengthened. So God here is calling Peter, James, and John to have faith in him. They were also told from the clouds by the voice of the Father, that this was God's beloved son and they should listen to him.

And we allow God's grace to work in our lives when we listen to him. God wants us to give him a chance, to listen to him, to listen to the words of the master. Even at times during Mass, I am tempted with distractions. Many of you may also be tempted with distractions, which keep us from truly entering into the mystery. May we not become discouraged with our distractions, but instead recognize them, and gently turn back to God again in our prayer and focus, and thereby make a whole new act of love all over again for God. When we listen to Jesus, we will be drawn into his presence. to the very life of Christ, and we will put on Christ, and begin to live as his brothers and sisters, with the love of God in our hearts. And that is what will transform us.

When we become imitators of Christ, we become transformed, too. And we were! We were transformed first before most of us even realized it, in our baptisms, when we became children of God, when we put on Christ. But then the darkness of sin began to creep back into our lives and we needed to be reconciled once again. So we are reconciled in that great sacrament of reconciliation. That is also a sacrament that transforms us!

We will be transformed again, also, when Christ comes again. We will be transformed bodily as well as spiritually. We will have glorified bodies, bodies which will shine as we imitate Christ! May this Lent give us the opportunity to look forward to what Paul tells us in the second reading, that Christ will "give a new form to this lowly body of ours and remake it according to the pattern of His glorified body."




