

Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten

Holy Week - April 13, 2025

This week, as we enter into the most solemn season of the Church year: Holy Week, our thoughts are drawn to how horribly the people treated Jesus. We hear this weekend of the fickleness of the crowd. One minute they were shouting "Hosanna to the Son of David," praising Jesus on Palm Sunday. And yet how shallow their words. Then, a few days later, with the same voices, they called for Jesus' execution. And isn't it that way with us, too. We say one thing, praising Christ, then we turn around and tear other people down, and crucifying Christ in one another.

Our thoughts are also drawn to what Jesus did for us fallen human beings, how he changed the world forever, giving us hope for eternal life. He did this by dying for us on the cross, out of love for us, and out of obedience to the Father. Although we couldn't be there physically in Jerusalem two thousand years ago, the reading of the passion helps us mentally to put ourselves in the place of those who witnessed that great trial and called for the Lord's death. The king - Jesus, who deserved the greatest praise for being the Son of God, received the most cruel and humiliating treatment. And he did it all for us!

So may we accept our Lord's offer of reconciliation each day, continuing the process of conversion to Christ. I invite those of you who can, to become a part of the days this week that recall our redemption from sin, giving us the promise of new life! The Mass on Holy Thursday recalls our Lord's Last Supper, when Jesus began the eucharistic sacrifice, in which He offers His body and blood to us every time we celebrate the Mass. It also recalls the new covenant of loving one another as Jesus has loved us when he washed the feet of his disciples. The Good Friday service, besides being a day of fasting and abstaining from meat, recalls Jesus' passion and death. Hopefully it will be a day of prayer for all of us. The Easter Vigil on Saturday evening is the night of nights! It recalls our Lord's glorious resurrection.

If you can't be a part of this special event (it really is one event, even though it covers three days), I ask you to be with us in prayer, keeping in mind what we are remembering on each of those days. And let us pray that more people will turn to Jesus, and accept His offer of love peace, and hope.
