**Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten**

**the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter - May 11, 2025**

In the gospel today, Jesus says he is a shepherd. In fact, elsewhere in the gospels, Jesus calls himself the good shepherd. The opposite of a good shepherd would be a bad shepherd. A bad shepherd might leave one's flock unattended, and forget about his job. But Jesus doesn't do that. He is constantly here for us.

And what are the sheep called to do? If a person examines sheep in a pasture in places they still have shepherds, they follow the shepherd. They know the shepherd's voice. It is important for us to know the Lord's voice. It is Jesus whose words were spoken today in the scriptures. They are not only Luke's or John's words, they are essentially God's words to us. How to apply these words to our daily lives takes prayer. It takes a deep, day-to-day relationship with God.

It is fitting that we have this gospel passage on this day, because today is the world day of prayer for vocations, vocations to the priesthood, brotherhood, and sisterhood. Ask just about any priest, brother, or sister why they are such, they will tell you that it is because they heard Jesus' calling. Jesus tells us in the gospel "My sheep hear my voice; I know them and they follow me." Listening to the shepherd's voice takes prayer, regularly, every day, as individuals and as families.

Part of our duty as Christians is to pray for one another, and to encourage young men and women to a possible calling to a religious vocation. Sometimes they don't see that calling in their hearts, but it needs to be brought to mind by someone else, inviting them to think and to pray about it.

May Jesus, who is the good shepherd, help us to do what he did, to go out and spread the good news of salvation to everyone, and to follow Him, the one who leads us to streams of living water.

## Jubilee Year of 2025

### Pilgrimages Offered by the Diocese of Fargo

**Corpus Christi Camino:** a 3-day walking pilgrimage along the North Country Trail, ending at Maryvale, Valley City, in June 2025.

A 4-day walking/hiking pilgrimage along the North Country Trail, beginning on the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi* (June 22), Dazey, ND, and ending at Maryvale, Valley City, on June 25, 2025.

Pilgrims will camp overnight on the parish grounds before beginning the Camino the next morning. The Camino will follow the North Country Scenic Trail all the way to Maryvale outside of Valley City. All meals provided. **Not included are camping equipment, tents, etc.** There will be transportation of camping equipment to the midway point, Mel Reiman Campground, and then again to Maryvale. Total: 23 miles.

Must be 12 years old or older. An adult must accompany all minors. The cost is \$95 per adult, ages 12-17 are \$75 per person. You will also have campsite fees. For more information go to <https://www.fargodiocese.org/jubilee-camino>



**Prairie Pilgrimage:** a 2-day bus tour of the six Jubilee sites in the Diocese of Fargo, August 25-26, 2025. We will begin at Maryvale, Valley City, and end back at Maryvale. All meals and overnight lodging included. This also includes an overnight stay at the Jasper hotel in downtown Fargo. You will also get reserved seating for the "Man of the Shroud" presentation at St. Mary's Cathedral. The cost is \$285 per person, double occupancy; or \$385 for a single room.

## NO Blessed Sacrament Mass on Cable TV!

Why is our Mass NOT being shown on the West Fargo Public Access Cable Channel? The City of West Fargo runs the equipment that broadcasts onto the West Fargo Public Access Cable Channel. For several months now, we have been in communication with the City of West Fargo Technology Department, trying to get the Mass back on TV.

- The City is aware that their equipment is getting older and experiences technical difficulty.
  - We have asked about the possibility of a technology upgrade.
- There have been changes in staff in the city IT department. Making it hard to communicate with someone that understands the system.
- The West Fargo City Offices have moved to a new location.
  - The IT Department has not moved the system that broadcasts our Sunday Mass. They feel it is not worth moving.
- We have been told this is NOT a high priority issue. The City might decide to discontinue the service rather than upgrade technology.

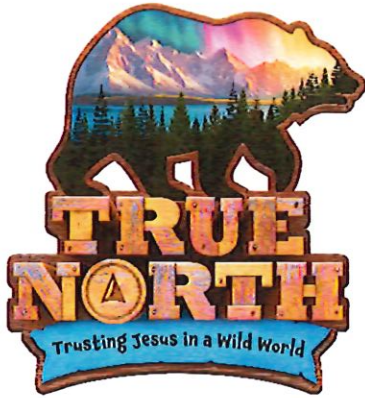

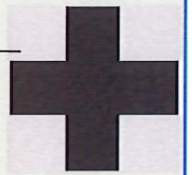
