Reflections by Fr. Gary Luiten

the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ June 22, 2025

On this special weekend, I would like to talk about something that is very important, and even core to our faith, and it comes between the processional and the recessional of the Mass, and that is *the Eucharist*. Jesus, our high priest of the new covenant, offers the new sacrifice, not cows or pigeons or wheat or barley, like the priests did in the old Jewish covenant, but the very Body and Blood of Jesus himself, following the Lord's command to "Do this in memory of me."

Jesus prepared the people for his ultimate gift of Himself by multiplying the loaves and fish and feeding the people in this weekend's gospel. And so, what we receive today is not loaves and fish. It is not even bread and wine. *It is the very Body and Blood of Christ*. If we really believe that, if we really think that it is Jesus, perhaps it will cause us to be a just a little bit more reverent, a little more respectful in the way we come to receive Jesus, in the way we come to Mass, and how often we attend Mass.

We do not come simply to hear the Word of God, although this is important. But when you think of it, the Word of God can be read and spoken at home. We come to Mass to do something we can't do at home: to receive the Body and Blood of Christ! That is the greatest gift we can receive.

Because of our membership in the Body of Christ, Jesus has left us a legacy. He has given us an inheritance upon his death and resurrection, and that is the Eucharist. So, the Body and Blood of Christ is also our inheritance. We know that sometimes when people inherit things, they must pay a tax on it. Our inheritance tax upon receiving this gift from Jesus is to offer our prayers, lives, and witness to God in union with Christ until His mission of salvation is fulfilled. Basically, you and I are called to go out and live what we receive.

When we attend Mass, you may not like the homily. You may not like the priest, you may not like the music, and you may not particularly like some of those here at Mass. Hopefully you do. But even if you don't, you still have the greatest gift offered to you: the very Body and Blood of Jesus. May we never take this awesome gift for granted, but rather use this gift for the building up of the kingdom of God in our daily lives.
